About the Role:

Our Community Vet Clinics promise to never turn away a sick or suffering animal irrespective of an owner's capacity to pay for veterinary care. Our aim is to keep pets and families together and avoid unnecessary euthanasia or surrender by providing owners with access to veterinary care and financial support through discounted vet treatment and repayment schemes. This charter means that our clinics are exciting and busy and offer a varied case load for our vet team.

Our staff are passionate about animals and have dedicated their careers to veterinary medicine and animal welfare, with vets on our team with over 20 years' experience. All profits from the clinics help fund the re-homing and treatment of the thousands of abandoned and stray animals at the Animal Welfare League QLD.

We are seeking a motivated Veterinarian to deliver high quality care to our patients. This includes communicating treatment plans to owners, coordinating care of patients, providing medical and surgical treatment and promoting preventative health care.

If you have an interest in shelter work, alternate shifts are available.

This position works on a part time work life balance roster on a four week cycle (28 days) to the value of 138 hours, working 1 in every 4 weekends.

Key Responsibilities:

- Conduct activities to a standard of the Veterinary Surgeons Board of QLD and AWLQ policy
- Desex small animals
- Assess, diagnose and treat sick/injured animals by prescribing appropriate treatment
- Carry out routine examinations and diagnosis
- Prescribe and administer medications and anaesthesia

- Carry out routine surgical procedures and perform radiographic procedures
- Perform pathological testing in accordance with infection control protocols
- Perform euthanasia and surgical autopsy as required
- Perform emergency procedures and operations
- Communicate accurate and professional veterinary advice to clients
- Meet animal health regulatory and legislative requirements
- Provide owners with preventative health care information
- Communicate diagnosis and treatment plans
- Generate estimates for cost of treatment
- Remain up to date with developments in the veterinary medicine profession and keep informed on all governing regulations e.g. Veterinary Surgeons Board QLD, Australian Veterinary Association, and Queensland Health
- Maintain comprehensive clinical records
- Comply with WH&S duties and maintain clinic hygiene in accordance with clinic policies and procedures

To be eligible to apply for this role, you must address the following selection criteria:

1. Degree in Veterinary Science and Registration with the Queensland Veterinary Surgeons Board
2. Radiation Use License
3. Authorised Implanter Number (AIN)
4. Demonstrated experience in a clinical setting
5. Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with internal and external stakeholders
6. Ability to analyse issues from different viewpoints, identify hidden problems and implement solutions
7. Strong Time Management/organisational skills
8. Versatility - Able to modify one's own behavioural style to respond to the needs of others while maintaining one's own objectives
9. Strong attention to detail, and seeks to provide quality veterinary care at all times
10. Discerns presenting symptoms and signs of a patient to formulate an accurate diagnosis
